

TOWN OF AURORA
MINUTES OF REGULAR BOARD MEETING
Thursday, May 14, 2026

The Aurora Town Board met at the town hall on Wednesday, April 15, 2026. Officers present were Chairman CJ Young, Supervisor II Andy Przybyl, and Clerk Ann Mosling.

CJ called the monthly meeting to order at 7:08 pm.

The Clerk verified the meeting Agenda was posted at these locations: 1) Town of Aurora website (www.townaurora.com), 2) Town Hall board, and 3) Town board located at Midway Gas and Oil. **A motion was made by Andy, and seconded by CJ, to approve the agenda and proceed with the meeting. Motion carried.**

A motion was made by CJ, and seconded by Andy, to approve the following minutes and enter them into the official record: 1) Road Inspection held on April 12, 2026, 2) Annual Meeting held on April 15, 2026, and 3) April Regular Board Meeting held on April 15, 2026. Motion carried.

Officers' Reports

A) Treasurer's Report: *not available*

B) Clerk:

- Fire alarm system passed inspection 4/21/26 performed by Ahern. Now Fire Inspection Services is able to come back and perform a second inspection of the hall's fire extinguishers.
- Wisconsin Towns Association has proposed a town resolution to protect our local roads for presentation to state legislators. After discussion, CJ and Andy have agreed to sign the resolution, however, this item needs to be brought to next month's meeting as new business so that it may be passed.
- City of Berlin charging \$12,374.15 (\$2,474.3 per month) for 5-month 2026 EMS Service contract. Check is included in this month's distribution. EMS Service contract with Waushara County-PoySippi begins on June 1, 2026.
- County Board approved Ordinance No. 707 "Ordinance amending Waushara County Codes Nos. 8, 54 and 58" in April 2026.

C) Board:

- EMS service contract to start June 1st. County might experience a few glitches during service conversion from City of Berlin to PoySippi. PoySippi EMS doesn't have the jaws of life – this service will have to come from Berlin EMS.

Business

1. **A motion was made by Andy, and seconded by CJ, to sign the PoySippi Volunteer Fire Department Rescue Service 2026 Annual Service Cost Agreement. Motion carried.**
2. A discussion about Roadside Mowing applicants is tabled until next month's meeting.
3. **A motion was made by Andy, and seconded by CJ, to approve the license applications received from the Berlin River Riders for their Truck & Tractor Pull**

scheduled July 18 & 19, 2026, at N312 State Road 49. A Temp Class B Beer license will be issued for the two-day event, and a 2-year Operator's License will be renewed and issued to Tyler Polfuss. Motion carried.

4. **A motion was made by Andy, and seconded by CJ, to approve an Electronics Recycling event at the Town Hall on August 1, 2026 to enable residents to recycle non-hazardous electronics equipment free of cost. Motion carried.**

5. Road report: discussion and decisions pertaining to maintenance and improvement.

- A. The county highway department has filled potholes in Aurora's roads.
B. Ann to call Ripon Truck about remaining bill for snow plowing

Current projects:

- i. Get quotes for 34th cutoff road for Aug/Sept timeframe. *Project on hold while city studies how Hwy 21 is holding up with geo-grid mat.*
ii. Replace culvert on Chicago. *Replaced 2 culverts. Completed*

Future projects:

- Blacktop town hall parking lot and repair storm drainage *WEC election audit rpt requirement*
 - 2026 crack fill/seal coating projects if we have the money:
 - o E. Waushara – from Retzlaff's to top of the hill, approximately 1 mile
 - o Side streets off of E. Waushara
 - o 32nd Dr (road to Walmart): ditching, need quote on overlay, roadway sagging at culvert (culvert itself verified OK)
 - o Cypress -- Fill crossline cracks to prevent dipping
 - o Cottonville – culvert
 - o LRIP
 - o County suggests to swap county and town ownership of roadways 34th (cuf-off road to Walmart) and Cty XX, city putting new option traffic counters on both roads to monitor traffic
- Issues: board reports there are still semi-trucks heavily using Cty XX
34th is currently posted "no trucks"
Cty XX is 1.5 miles longer than 34th for maintenance purposes
semis can't make S-curve on Cty XX & tearing up the shoulder*
- CJ to work with Dave-City Hwy Dept to apply for road-funding grants:
 - o LRIP: Program is 5yr rotation cycle and comes up in next 2 years. Start by Oct'27 to meet due date 1-15-28.
Bid projects as asphalt only.
 - o ARIP: for 34th cut-off road to Walmart

6. **A motion was made by Andy, and seconded by CJ, to approve the scheduled payments. Motion carried.**

As there was no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:55 pm.
